Day 1 Suvarnabhumi Airport – Wat Phra Kaew - Wat Ratchanadda (Loha Prasat)
The Giant Swing - Wat Pho - Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn) - Sor Vorapin Muay Thai Gym
Iconsiam - Cruise Dinner

- 07:30 am. You Arrive at Suvarnabhumi Airport. Meet our tour guide at the airport.
- 08:30 am. Arrive at Wat Phra Kaew (The Temple of The Emerald Buddha), that is beautifully decorated. The elaborately decorated holy buildings, statues, and pagodas that houses the Emerald Buddha. It is the most important icon for Thai people.
- 09:30 am. Visit to Wat Ratchanatdaram Worawiharn (Loha Prasat) is an exquisite temple, making one of the important landmarks in Bangkok. The word Loha means metal, and Prasat means castle. And yes, the fascinating thing is that this is the first metal castle built in Thailand, and is the 3rd in the world. It is then not a usual thing we can see this type of architecture, so exploring its magnificence is not to be missed!
- 10:30 am. Then Ride Tuk Tuk to The Giant Swing you can still enjoy the beauty and uniqueness of it. Standing at over 21 meters (69ft) tall, the Giant Swing is a Brahman religious structure, and was originally used as part of a ceremony during the Brahman Festival.
- 11:00 am. Visit to Wat Pho or “ Temple of the Reclining Buddha ” is definitely one of Bangkok’s most attractive temples. It is also one of Thailand’s most visited temples for its huge Reclining Buddha image it houses. Since it’s located south of the Grand Palace, it’s perfect for a day of temple hopping in Bangkok.

- 01:15 pm. cross the Chao Phraya River by ferry to Ta Tien Pier.
- 01:30 pm. Visit to Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn), see the beauty of the architecture and the fine craftsmanship. The prang (spire) by the Chao Phraya is one of Bangkok's world famous landmarks. The imposing spire rises over 70 metres high, beautifully decorated with tiny pieces of coloured glass and Chinese porcelain placed delicately into intricate patterns.
- 03:00 pm. Arrive at " Sor Vorapin Muay Thai Gym " Sor Vorapin is Boxing Camp and recognised as home of expert trainers in international boxing, it can be seen in our students who are Thai boxing champions and World boxing champions of I.B.F and W.B.O!
- Activity** - boxing show.
- watch a show Wai Kru is a ritual performance and dance to pay homage, gratitude, and respect to the boxer's trainers both in the present and the ones from his past.

- 05:00 pm. Relax and enjoy shopping at Iconsiam. A large shopping center building along the Chao Phraya River. which has the 2nd largest total area and largest total sales area in Thailand.
- 06:30 pm. Check in Chao Phraya Princess Cruise at the River City Pier.
- 07:30 pm. Relax during a dinner cruise on the Chao Phraya River that includes entertainment and panoramic views of Bangkok.
- 10.00 pm. Check in hotel safely. Relax time.



Day 2 Umbrella Folding Market - Take the boat to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market
Tiger Cave Temple - Bridge Over the River Kwai

- 07.00 am. Breakfast at hotel.
- 08.00 am. Check out hotel and heading to Ratchaburi.
- 09:30 am. Arrive at Mae Klong Railway Market. Stalls are arranged all over the railway line as hundreds of people go about their shopping. Suddenly a train approaches as the market folds away and lets the train pass through. Then in a matter of seconds, it unfolds back into a busy market. Known among the locals as “ Talad Roam-Hoop ”, which literally translate to “ Umbrella Folding Market ”
- 10:30 am. Arrive at the pier to take the boat to the centre of the market. Enjoy the scenery of the Thai countryside to get to the heart of Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. One of the biggest, and definitely the most popular floating market in the region. Experience exotic as the vendors display and sell their goods on the paddle boat, it will take you back to the ancient Thai way of living that is still practised to this day. Tack your Lunch.
- 02:30 pm. Arrive at Tiger Cave Temple (Wat Tham Suea), is built in a mixed, splendid Thai-Chinese style and enshrines a huge Buddha image. Located not far from Tham Khao Noi Temple, Wat Tham Suea is famous for its spacious space, the sacred gilded Buddha Images, which is Kanchanaburi's largest, and interesting architectural style influenced by Chinese arts.
- 04:30 pm. Arrive at the Bridge Over the River Kwai. This took the form of the now-infamous Death Railway, constructed by the Japanese using the forced labour many civilians from Southeast Asia and prisoners of war from the Allies' forces.
- 05:00 pm. Take dinner.
- 06:30 pm. Check in Hotel. Relax



Day 3 Erawan waterfall - Tham Krasae - Ride The Train at the Death Railway

- 07.00 am. Breakfast at hotel.
- 08:00 am. Check out, heading to Erawan Waterfall
- 09:15 am. Relax at **Erawan waterfall**, a 2-km continuously in its length cuddled by a variety of plants. The water descended over the layers of the limestone created the distinctive shape similar to the head of Erawan Elephant (3-head elephant). Each tier of the cascade offers a cold and fresh pond that allows the visitors to play in the transparent turquoise water leisurely.
- 11:40 am. Arrive at **Krasae Cave** is located along the cliff near the **Tham Krasae railway station (The Death Railway)**. Inside the airy cave and a sacred Buddha image enshrined Looking from the mouth of the cave to the railway area, you will see **the most beautiful view point** and see the Kwai Noi River below.
- 12:30 pm. Train ride from Tham Krasae railway station to Nam Tok railway station.
- 01:00 pm. Arrive at **Nam Tok** railway station.
- 02:30 pm. Check in Hotel. Relax with the hotel

It was added to the list in 1991 citing its role in shaping the history and culture of Thailand. The old city of Ayutthaya spans about 400 years in history. It was once a prosperous capital of trade and politics in Thailand.
- 11:30 am. **Take lunch**
- 12:45 pm. Arrive at **Wat Phra Si Sanphet**, is part of the Royal Palace complex, the **very large monastery with dozens of structures** was used by Ayutthaya Kings only, it was a Royal temple without monks.
- 02:00 pm. Arrive at **Wat Mahathat**, “ **the temple of the Great Relic** ” was one of the most important temples in the Ayutthaya Kingdom. Located on the historical island **the large monastery**. One of the temple's most photographed objects is the head of a stone Buddha image entwined in the roots of a tree.
- 04:00 pm. Arrive at **Ayothaya Floating Market** enjoy the pleasant environment and gorgeous scenery in a Thai style. You can ride elephant, savour some tasty and delicious food, or shop for souvenirs at various stores scattered around the Market.
- 05:00 pm. **Take dinner**
- 07:45 pm. **Heading to Chiang Mai by Overnight Train.**
